This fall we are engaged in a study of the elementary boundaries. At our PTO meeting last week Dr. Ronneberg briefly explained the reason for the boundary change. One of the reasons is that Westwood is full and as the Spanish Immersion program grows we will need to find a permanent home for the program. This is only one of the reasons. We also need to look at the use of each of our facilities and using them at an optimal level to meet the needs of our students, we need to balance the enrollment as best we can at each of the elementary buildings as well.
