## From the desk of the principal ... Mr. Larson

Thursday of next week is a two hour early release. The students will be dismissed at 1:15. This is our second of three early releases during the school year. We are very fortunate to have this time as a staff to continue to grow professionally and to meet the needs of kids. On Friday, 1/27 there is no school for kids. Thursday and Friday the staff will be evaluating how students are doing based on both DIBELS data and NWEA data. The staff will determine if what they are doing in their classrooms, small groups, and specific interventions for kids are working. They will also plan out next steps in kids learning. In addition to this each professional learning community will provide an update on their reading and math goals. Finally, the staff will use time to prepare for conferences the following week.

Intermediate students do not need snow pants they are encouraged, but they should be wearing jackets, boots, hats, mittens or gloves. We do not keep kids inside unless the temperature is below zero or a wind-chill factor of -10.
